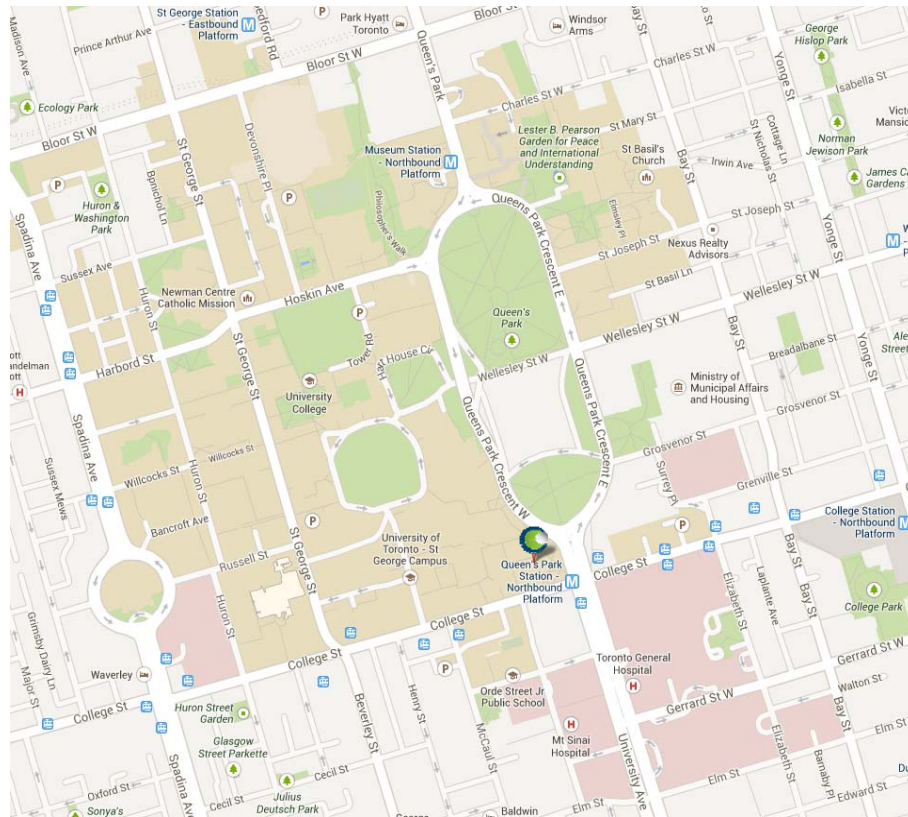
Purpose
